Illinois has a Truth-in-Sentencing
law. you must do 100% For
Murder and 85% for other crimes.

In 1995 Illinois passed a TRUTH-
in-Sentencing law. no more day-
for-day (do half of your sentence)
the bill was over turned in 1997
because it violated the single subject
rule of the Illinois State Constitution.

It was a bill for Hospitals
and other things, not just about
crime. In 1998 the Bill was
re-done

The Excessive Sentencing laws have piled up in Illinois. (Truth-in-sentencing laws, Firearm enhancements, The Habitual Criminal Act and Accountability laws) these laws must be repealed.

Illinois abolished parole in 1978, and the I.D.O.C. budget ballooned from 52 million to nearly \$1.5 billion. Illinois needs a fair Parole System until these laws are repealed and applied retroactively.

The Illinois Constitution Article I Section, 11 states "that all criminal penalties shall be determined both according to the seriousness of the offense and with the objective of restoring the offender to useful citizens".
