Anywho these fascist people look for any reason to deny me or any other self aware man an opportunity to learn more about what it is either we can do or what we can direct our support system to do. All they know here at this concentration camp is lying, oppression, and repression. Every day around here is a constant battle with the devil and his imps. To make this point even clearer on January 29 of this year I was taken to the hole while only wearing a pair of shorts and a t-shirt in -22 degree weather it was so cold that the control center ordered the c.o.'s in the hole to give us a third blanket. So I don't expect anything but chaos and B.S.

So how is Sincere doing. Please give him my regards and tell him to keep his head up. As for myself I am currently preparing to file litigation against the administration here for the desparate treatment between the Eastside of the prison and the Westside of the prison. Both sides are level II, but the Westside has many more perks if there is such a word in prison. But they get 2 1/2 more hours of yard and an additional hour of dayroom. This is compounded by the fact that the administration here does not follow the policy governing prisoner discipline. Which calls for progressive discipline which consists of counselor reprimand to extra duty, to loss of privilege, to toplock. Here they only believe in toplock and they use it as a form of population control. Also i'm trying to create a medium that would allow for us to be able to get our issues out to the public. I don't have a specific name yet but an idea one name is Families/Friends Against Repression. This organization could air issues such as mail rejection directly to state legislator's and the direct of the MDCC and as such would have a better standing against the MDCC because they are citizens/taxpayers. If you have any suggestions feel free. I've kept you long enough, take care and stay strong.
